records regarding the methodology and/or assumptions used to estimate \$3.4 billion in additional income tax revenue under Gov. Pritzker's proposed income tax rate structure, including but not limited to:

- Number of returns in each of the proposed income brackets
- Total income generated from the tax returns in each income bracket
- Total income tax revenues from the tax returns in each income bracket
