Budget Crisis: Statewide Opinion Survey

Cook County and Rest of State Differ on Budget Crisis

CHICAGO, IL - Ogden & Fry, conducted an 8-question survey for **Illinois Policy Action** on Monday & Tuesday, October 19-20, 2015 with 898 respondents. The survey has a margin of error of +/-3.34%. Respondents were selected by random sampling of likely 2016 voters.
