Ms. Huffman:

The undersigned is legal counsel for the Board of Trustees of the East St. Louis Police Pension Fund ("Pension Board"). This correspondence serves as the Pension Board's "Statement of Notification" of a claim eligible to be remitted pursuant to 40 ILCS 5/3-125(c) and 74 Ill. Adm. Code 295, *et seq.* The following information is provided pursuant to 74 Ill. Adm. Code 295.300.

Attached are the completed required Comptroller's forms:

- 1. Statement of Notification (Form C-33p), and
- 2. Pension Fund Collection Authorization (Form SC0-501p)

Terms Defined:

- 1. Claimant: City of East St Louis Police Pension Fund
- 2. Chief Executive Officer: Nicholas Mueller Pension Board President
- 3. **Person**: City of East St. Louis ("the City")

Statement of Notification Information Pursuant to 74 Ill. Adm. Code 295.300(c):

1. The name and FEIN or Government Unit Code for the person against whom the claim exists:

City of East St. Louis, Illinois

FEIN: 37-6001941

2. The certified amount delinquent then due and payable to the fund: \$1,789,255.

3. The reasons why there is an amount due to the fund: There is an amount due to the Pension Fund because the City failed to contribute the statutory minimum, Annual Actuarial Requirement ("AAR") to the Pension Fund for fiscal years 2017 and 2018 as required by 40 ILCS 5/3-125 (a) and (b) of the Pension Code. The City of East St. Louis has chronically underfunded the East St. Louis Police Pension Fund. According to the Illinois Department of Insurance's Actuarial Valuation Report for the East St. Louis Police Pension Fund as of January 1, 2018, the Pension Fund is only 35% funded. (Bd.Exh.5, p.66).

According to a response from the City of East St. Louis to a FOIA request, the City has not done a private actuarial valuation report for fiscal years ending 2015, 2016 and 2017 for the Pension Fund. (Bd.Exh.6, p.69, Bd.Exh.7, p.71 and Bd.Exh.9, p.88).

Since at least 2016, the Pension Fund has engaged the services of an independent enrolled actuary, Jason Franken of Foster and Foster, to determine an actuarial valuation for the East St. Louis Police Pension Fund. (Bd.Exh.3, p.9, Bd.Exh.12, p.126 and Bd.Exh.11, p.95). The Pension Fund forwards a copy of that independent actuarial valuation report to the City, recommending a required municipal contribution to the Pension Fund, as required by §3-143 of the Pension Code. (Bd.Exh.3, p.7, Bd.Exh.12, p.124)

On or about September 21, 2016, the Illinois Department of Insurance issued its Actuarial Valuation Report for the City of East St. Louis Police Pension Fund as of January 1, 2016. (Bd.Exh.1, p.1-2). The Department's recommended statutory minimum for fiscal year 2017 was \$2,045,760. (Bd.Exh.1, p.2).

According to the City of East St. Louis Police Pension Fund's Audited Financial Statement for year ending December 31, 2017, the total amount of contributions to the Pension Fund made by the City during fiscal year 2017 totaled \$714,929, or \$1,330,831 less than the statutory minimum required by §3-125 (a) and (b) of the Pension Code. (Bd.Exh.4, p.48).

On or about August 31, 2017, the Illinois Department of Insurance issued its Actuarial Valuation Report for the City of East St. Louis Police Pension Fund as of January 1, 2017. (Bd.Exh.2, p.4-5). The Department's recommended statutory minimum for fiscal year 2018 was \$2,113,441. (Bd.Exh.2, p.5).

According to the City of East St. Louis Police Pension Fund's Audited Financial Statement for year ending December 31, 2018, the total amount of contributions to the Pension Fund made by the City during fiscal year 2018 totaled <u>\$1,655,017</u>, or <u>\$458,424</u> less than the statutory minimum required by §3-125 (a) and (b) of the Pension Code. (Bd.Exh.13, p.170).

- 4. The time period to which the claim is attributable: For fiscal years 2017 and 2018. The Pension Fund's fiscal year begins on January 1 and ends on December 31 of each year.
- 5. A description of the type of notification given to the person against whom the claim exists and the type of opportunity to be heard afforded that person: Written notice was served upon the City attorney and Mayor on September 11, 2019. (Bd.Exh.14, p.186), notifying the City of a hearing scheduled for September 26, 2019 for

purposes of determining whether the Pension Board should file an "intercept" claim with the Comptroller's office.²

- 6. A statement as to the outcome of any hearings or other proceedings held to establish the claim, or a statement that no hearing was requested: A hearing was held before the Pension Board on September 26, 2019 pursuant to proper and timely notice. The City appeared through its representatives, as follows: Mayor Robert Eastern, III, City Manager Brooke Smith, City Clerk Debra Tidwell, City Board Administrator Dorene Hooseman and City Corporate Counsel John Baricevic. The City acknowledged receipt of the notice of hearing and exhibits #1-14, which are attached hereto and incorporated herein. The City raised no objection to admission of said exhibits into evidence without the need of further authentication, foundation or live testimony. The City did not contest the delinquent amount of \$1,789,255 as certified by the Board. The Pension Board certified said delinquency and authorized the Board President and counsel to execute any and all documents or forms as may be required and to file said claim with the Comptroller's Office. (A copy of the September 26, 2019 Hearing Transcript is attached hereto as Bd.Exh.15)
- 7. The date of the final determination of the claim: September 26, 2019.

The claimant submits this Statement of Notification to the Comptroller and it requests that the Comptroller deduct and remit to the Pension Fund the certified amount from the total amount of any payments of State funds to the City of East St. Louis in accordance with 40 ILCS 5/3-125 et seq. including but not limited to subsection (c) thereof and any and all rules and procedures of the Comptroller's Officer including, but not limited to: 74 Ill. Adm. Code 295.400 through 295.700. A copy of the Notification of Claim letter to the Mayor is also included herein.

Please consider this letter an Illinois Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA") request to the City of East St. Louis. On September 3, 2019, you provided the City's response to my August 29, 2019 FOIA request, submitted on behalf of the Board of Trustees of the East St. Louis Police Pension Fund. Said response does not appear to identify, specifically, all monies collected from any and all sources for the benefit of the East St. Louis Police Pension Fund for the calendar years 2017 and 2018. Nor does said response appear to identify all monies paid or transferred by the City of East St. Louis to or on account of the East St. Louis Police Pension Fund, from any and all sources (as required by 40 ILCS 5/3-125) for the years 2017 and 2018.

Pursuant to the above paragraph, please provide the following for the calendar years 2017, 2018 and January 1, 2019, through and inclusive of the present date:

- 1. All records/documents identifying all monies collected (from any source) by the City of East St. Louis designated for Police Pension Fund;
- 2. All records/documents identifying any and all <u>payments made</u> by the City of East St. Louis to or on account of the East St. Louis Police Pension Fund from any source, the same representing compliance with any tax levy request submitted by the East St. Louis Police Pension Fund Board; and
- 3. Copies of any and all actuarial valuations provided by the State or certified actuaries which the City may have relied upon for funding of the East St. Louis Police Pension Fund for the aforementioned years.

Again, we are asking that you, as the City Clerk, certify that the documents provided in reply to this FOIA, are true and accurate.

Please also note that the aforementioned information must be provided within the five (5) day period required by the Freedom of Information Act.

In a separate correspondence, the municipality shall be provided a "Notice of Hearing" scheduled for September 26, 2019 at 12:00 p.m. before the Board of Trustees of the East St. Louis Police Pension Fund. The purpose of this hearing shall be to determine whether or not the municipality has complied with the funding requirements of statute. You are further notified that the Board may issue a subpoena requesting the presence of Willie D. Arnold, as City Treasurer and/or yourself, as City Clerk, to present testimony before the Board, at hearing.

Your prompt attention to this matter is greatly appreciated.
